Two men rescued!


Two men were rescued by the emergency services

In my opinion, junk food such as fries burgers and so on, aren't very good for us. But, many people might not agree. So, we need to look at both sides of the question.





Alfabet Science Lab

Would you like to make your own lava lamp? Have you ever made a smoke bomb or blown a balloon with the help of baking soda? No?! Our brilliant young scientists will show you how!



Nikola M. is our expert on smoke bombs. He has made dozens of them and he agreed to tell us his secret recipe for making a smoke bomb. "BUT" - HE ADDS, "IT CAN BE DANGEROUS. DO NOT TRY THIS WITHOUT A GROWN UP NEXT TO YOU!"

"First, you need to mix 60 gramms of sugar and 60 gramms of Potassium nitrate (kalijum nitrat). Then you heat this mixture until the sugar melts and becomes liquid and caramel like. Carefully pour the mixture in a container where it would cool and harden. We used a cardboard tube from a paper roll. Do not forget to put a fuse in the mixture while it is still warm. The longer the fuse, the better."

Wait until the mixture is cold, go outside (in a park, for example), light the fuse and enjoy the surprised faces of your friends.

Aljoša (T.) showed us another BRILLIANT experiment.

"I want to show you how to make a lava lamp. It's easy. You need a big tall glass, a bit of water, lots of kitchen oil and an effervescent/carbon tablet (šumeća tableta) of your choice. Put a bit of water in a glass, fill the rest of the glass with oil and add a carbon tablet. Enjoy the show!"

Our lamp did not glow in the dark but it was one of the best lava lamps any of us have ever seen.



Your birthday is coming soon and you don't know how to blow all the balloons necessary for a good party? Here is an idea.

Put 40ml of water in a bottle, add a pack of baking soda and 40-60ml of vinegar (sirće). Quickly put the balloon on top of the bottle and see how it gets bigger and bigger on its own. For best results it is good to inflate the balloon couple of times on your own before using the bottle to do it! :-D

And if your neighbors are complaining about too much experimenting in your apartment you can always deal with them with a stink bomb!! This is how Srdjan (A.) does it. :D



